

SCHOOL BANKING



The academy runs a bank for pupils to save in; we are keen to run a savings system to begin to teach children about money management and encourage the savings ethos. Pupils can pay in money any day either via the office or classroom.

All money being paid in will need to come into school in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the child's name, class and academy bank on it. After the first deposit has been made you will receive a bank card and envelope ready for the next payment. The card must come in with each payment.

When your child wishes to make a withdrawal we will ask them to sign a slip and depending on the amount we will hand the money to them (or you if it is a large amount) within 3 working days. It is important that you countersign the permission slip.

In the past many of our parents have saved for school trips or uniform using the academy bank. This has proved very helpful to those parents and families and works in the same way as the system does for our pupils.
