Times Tables

Knowing the times tables is a fundamental, required skill and therefore children should be practising these as much as possible. Later this year, Year 4 will sit the National Multiplication Tables Check. The check is intended to help teachers identify pupils who have not yet mastered this important mathematical skill so we can give them additional support. Your help and support in assisting the children in their learning and practising of these is greatly appreciated.

By the end of Year 4, the expectation is that every child can recall multiplication and division facts up to 12 X 12.

PE and Swimming- IMPORTANT CHANGES

Our PE lessons are on now on MONDAYS and there will be swimming every Thursday. All children should have a PE kit in school. PE kits should be brought in on the first day of term and remain in school until the final PE lesson of the term. Please ensure that your child's name is clearly labelled on all uniform and PE kit items. If your child has their ear/s pierced, they need to be able to remove these themselves and keep them in a labelled box or envelope. If they are unable to remove their earrings, please ensure they are not wearing them on the days they have PE. For swimming, all long hair should be tied up in a bun. Children should wear their swimwear under their uniform and then bring underwear to change into. Please ensure your child brings a towel which is named.

Brainbuilders

Brainbuilders are completed weekly and are handed out on a Friday to be returned on a Wednesday.

These can normally be presented in a number of different ways, from a piece of writing, a poster or something creative.

Spellings
